The rap superstar may have just been crowned hip-hop's first billionaire, but that wasn't always the case. J.J. - born Sean Corey Carter in Brooklyn, New York - grew up in a Martian housing project with his mother. There, he told NPR in a 2010 interview, his only job is to survive. It was a very tense and tense situation, he told Fresh Air's Terry Gross. In 1996, his friends Damon Dash and Karim Burke founded their own label, Roc-a-Fella Records. In the same year, J-See released his debut album, Reasonable Doubt, and it instantly became a classic. He went on to release the hit after a hit record in the late 90s in the early 2000s, which earned him the first few million, Business Insider. But music isn't the only money maker for Jay-zee. In 1997, Jay-zee co-founded Rock clothes. In 2007, he turned around and sold the company for a steep \$204 million. In 2003, J.J. also acquired a small percentage of the New Jersey Nets, which helped revive even the team's move to Brooklyn. In 2013, he sold his part of the team for \$500,000. And in 2015, he acquired the company for music streaming service Tidal for \$56 million. Let us also not forget his stake in Armand de Brignac Champagne; his entertainment label Roc Nation, owned by Live Nation; sports and management division, started in 2013 under the name Roc Nation Sports; his investment in Jetsmarter; its stake in Uber; His real estate portfolio; and its upscale sports bar in Manhattan, known as the 40/40 Club.
